Case Study Mr Sitharaj, PALM 2 group member

Raja , PALM staff , included mr. Sitharaj into the NABARD Farmers Club 5 years ago. Mr. Sitharaj has 2 acres land where he cultivates 1 ½ acre mulberry plants for the silk production and ½ acre fruits and vegetables. At that time mr S. got 2000 rupees per month as an income . The income was not sufficient to feed his family and he thought of selling his property. Mr.S. has a wife and 3 daughters , the eldest is 20 years old .

Through hard work and continuous persistency in organic cultivation emphasized by PALM, his land became totally organic. Mr. S. bought 3 cows with a loan 2 years ago and started to use the cowdung for his bio compost and fertilizers. He learned about vermin compost and started a big vermin pit. His income increased

Mr. S. now obtains regular income from the cocoons and the fruits for an average 10000 rupees per month. He is now linked up with the organic federation nearby, and supplies all his products through the federation. Mr. S. has not employed any daily labor but he and hiswife do all the activitities.

Mr. S was the first farmer who used the total organic concept in mulberry cultivation and the Seri culture dept. selected him for a national award being the first farmer to practice total organic in sericulture.

Higher Officers now come to visit his farm and observe his practices. Mr. S. is now a model farmer to all the surrounding farmers and in the Thalavadi Block. He is sharing all his knowledge and experiences how to become a model farmer.

Mr. S recently could send his eldest daughter to a nursing school which is very expensive in india ,because of his increased profits. He is able to repay his loans in time now and has invested in a small motorbike.
